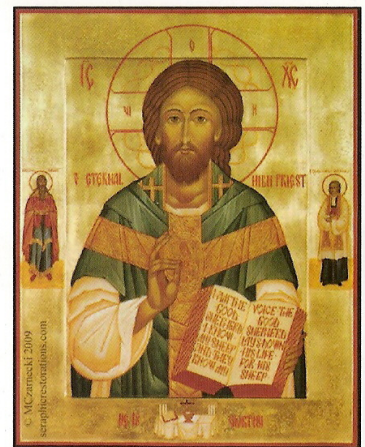
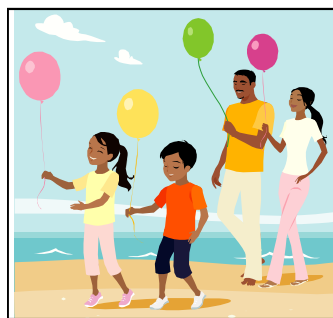

May, the Month of Mary

The angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her. She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus because he will save his people from their sins. When Joseph awoke, he did as the angel of the Lord hand commanded him and took Mary into his house." [Matthew 1:22 & 24]

The church sets aside the month of May to honor Mary, the mother of Jesus, and matriarch of the Holy Family. Pope Pius XII dedicated May 1st as the Feast of St. Joseph the Worker to promote the sacredness of labor against the rise of Communism in Russia. However, the honoring of Joseph dates back to the early 2nd century in the Eastern Church.

During the Month of May we honor our mothers on Mother's Day, a holiday often associated with Hallmark cards, chocolate candy and flowers. During this month when we honor our natural mothers, it is only fitting to honor our Heavenly Mother as well.

In a time where workers are treated more like a commodity

then persons, and labor is seen by corporate giants as an expense oppose to the sacredness of work as we find in the Scriptures. Family life in our modern world is often seen as a trial oppose to a long-term commitment, or the role of a mother and father is a convenience more than a relation we need models to guide us. Mary and Joseph provide us a model of what a family should be like. I grew up in a foster home with foster parents. I never really knew what a true or real family actually was.
